A Diamond Royal Flush® is a player's best friend!

The Caribbean Stud® Diamond Edition™ basic game consists of one five-card hand (face down) to each Player and one five-card poker hand to the Dealer, four-cards face-down and one card face up.

Note: Progressive side wager is optional at the beginning of each hand.

- Ante - Each Player makes this opening wager
- Bet or fold - If the Player thinks his/her hand will win (either by having a hand better than the Dealer or by the Dealer not qualifying)
 - The Player may place a Bet wager of twice the amount on the Ante.
 - The Player may elect to fold (forfeit their Ante) if they think the hand may not beat the Dealer.

- Dealer's Hand - Must contain an Ace-King or better to qualify.
- If the Dealer does not qualify, Players that made the Bet wager will be paid even money on their Ante wager only.
- If the Dealer qualifies (Ace-King or better), and the Player's hand is greater in poker ranking value than the dealer's hand, the Players are paid even money on their Ante wager and even money or odds on their Bet wager.

Base Game of Player vs. Dealer	Bet Wager Pays
Royal Flush	100 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Four-of-a-Kind	20 to 1
Full House	7 to 1
Flush	5 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Three-of-a-Kind	3 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
One Pair or less	1 to 1

Diamond Edition Progressive	Pays
Royal Flush in Diamonds	Jackpot
Royal Flush in Clubs, Hearts or Spades	50% of Meter
Straight Flush	\$5,000
Four-of-a-Kind	\$500
Full House	\$75
Flush	\$50
