

Fun 21 Blackjack



Fun 21 Blackjack is a variation of regular Blackjack. The basic rules and objective of the game are the same, but for added enjoyment, some additional options have been included to make the game more fun and exciting for the player.

RULES OF THE GAME

All 21's PAID IMMEDIATELY – You win automatically if you have “21”!!!

Player's 21 ALWAYS beats Dealer's 21.

Player's Blackjack ALWAYS beats Dealer's Blackjack (pays 3-2).

SPLITTING PAIRS

You may split any cards of equal value, including ACES, up to 4 times for a total of 5 hands. Just place a bet equal to your original bet in the bet box for each split. You may also hit and double all split hands.

DOUBLING DOWN

You may double down on any total and any number of cards (two card minimum) including after splitting.

DOUBLE DOWN SURRENDER

After doubling, if you are dissatisfied with a non-busted hand, you may take back the double portion of the bet and forfeit the original wager.

SURRENDER

You may surrender half your original bet after being dealt the first 2 cards providing you have not drawn any more cards. You cannot surrender on a split hand.

INSURANCE

Insurance is permitted.

BONUS PAYOUTS!!!

You will be paid 3 to 2 on your bet on the following:

5 or more cards totaling “21”

7-7-7 totaling “21”

6-7-8 totaling “21”

(No bonuses are paid on double down hands.)

DEALER'S CARDS

Dealer hits on soft 17.

Dealer checks for Blackjack.

Fun 21 Blackjack is played with 8 decks of cards with all Queens removed from the decks.

Face Up Blackjack

Have you ever wanted to see both of the dealer's cards Face Up? Here is your chance on Face Up Blackjack. As long as your hand beats the dealer's, you win.

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Both of the dealer's cards will be dealt Face Up.
2. All pushes lose except for when you have Blackjack.
3. Blackjack is paid even money.

4. There is no insurance.
5. You may split 2 cards of the same value once only. Split Aces draw one card only.
6. You may double down when your first 2 cards total “9,” “10” or “11” (including split hands).
7. Dealer draws to 16 and stands on all 17's.

It's that simple!!!
